
Appendix E

Hdfview

The recommended GUI for viewing your PH5 file is *hdfview*. It is an open-source GUI for data formats utilizing the HDF5 data model and is maintained by the open-source community.

Here is shown a *hdfview* screen shot with suggestions for use to view your PH5 file. Start *hdfview* via the command line shell script: hdfview.sh.



Remember the information stored within the PH5 may be edited with hdfview. While possible, we do **not** recommend this procedure for corrections as there is no method within *hdfview* to automatically undo edits (e.g. no "Control Z"). **Consider opening your PH5 file in the** "Read Only" mode, found under the File menu to avoid complications of unintentional edits.

The tabs available in the lower left corner of the GUI provide a log of activity within *hdfview* via the "Log info" tab and a summary of the table or array opened through the "Metadata" tab. In the example illustrated we selected the "Metadata" tab and see that we have selected the Das table (also highlighted in blue) and it is populated with 26 rows of information.
